With the permission of an NFLA board member, Sondreson Hall may be rented for non-NFLA functions. Fee for members are as follows:

- \$10 each for up to two hours, with a minimum of eight rentals
- \$25 for up to two hours, single rental
- \$50 for up to four hours, single rental
- \$75 per day

Damage deposit for members is equal to the rental fee.

Rental fee for non-members is \$150 per day, with a \$150 refundable damage deposit.

All agreements to rent are subject to revocation at any time with a proportionate refund of any monies advanced. Renters must leave the hall in the state of repair and cleanliness in which they found it. **Tables, chairs and other furnishings are not for rent**, and may not be removed from the hall.
